## U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at the Ellis Property Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its fourth Five-Year Review of the **Ellis Property Superfund** site located in **Evesham Township, Burlington County**. The purpose of this five-year review is to ensure that the implemented remedy (of the 1992 Record of Decision) remains protective. The original remedy at this site included the excavation and treatment of contaminated soils with disposal at an off-site facility, and installation of a pump-and-treat system to address contaminated groundwater at the site.

A summary of the review activities and evaluation of the long-term protectiveness of the remedy will be included in the upcoming Five-Year Review report.

### What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

### When will EPA's Five-Year Review Report be available?
