Please see the following list of Evesham Township facilities that are opened/closed at this time.

WHAT'S CLOSED

- The **Gibson House Community Center** and the **Blue Barn Recreation Center** remain **CLOSED** to members of the public at this time. If you need to contact one of these locations, please call the township's Main Number at (856) 983-2900.

WHAT'S OPEN

- **THE EVESHAM TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING (984 TUCKERTON ROAD)** and **PUBLIC WORKS OFFICES (100 SHARP ROAD)** are **OPEN** to members of the public. To enter these facilities, members of the public must wear a face covering at all times and maintain six feet of social distancing whenever possible. In addition, the township has installed additional Plexiglas shields on our countertops, and new hand sanitizer dispensers and floor decals will also be available to help members of the public.
- **NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS** and **MUNICIPAL PLAYGROUNDS** are currently **OPEN**. All state-mandated social distancing guidelines still apply. Whenever possible, individuals/families must keep at least six feet of distance from any other, non-household members who are also visiting the same site. Per executive order from the governor, face coverings are required to be worn outside (ages 2 and older) when six feet of social distancing between non-household members is not possible. Outdoor gatherings of more than 500 individuals are also still prohibited per state orders.
- **PLAYING FIELDS, PUBLIC TENNIS COURTS, BASEBALL DIAMONDS, HOCKEY RINKS** and **OUTDOOR BASKETBALL COURTS** are **OPEN**. (This does *not* include the **M1 Turf Field** at The Memorial Sports Complex, with that one specific field remaining **CLOSED** due to concerns raised by the results of an annual safety impact study conducted on the field. All other areas and equipment at The Memorial Sports Complex remain **OPEN** for safe use.) All state-mandated social distancing guidelines still apply. Whenever possible, individuals and families must keep at least six feet of distance from any other, non-household members who are also visiting the same site. Per executive order from the governor, face coverings are required to be worn outside (ages 2 and older) when not engaging in vigorous activity and six feet of social distancing between non-household members is not possible. Outdoor gatherings of more than 500 individuals are also still prohibited per state orders.

Per state rules, [organized, low-risk, non-contact sports](#), such as golf and tennis, could resume practice and competitions in outdoor settings on **June 22**. Check state websites for more.

Per state rules, [organized, medium-risk sports](#), such as baseball, softball, soccer, and outdoor basketball, could resume traditional practices and competitions in outdoor settings on **July 8**. Check state websites for more.

Per state rules, [organized, high-risk sports](#), such as football, could resume traditional practices and competitions in outdoor settings on **July 20**. Check state websites for more.

- **THE BLACK RUN PRESERVE** is **OPEN** to members of the public. All state-mandated social distancing guidelines still apply. Whenever possible, individuals/families must keep at least six feet of distance from any other, non-household members who are also visiting the same site. Per executive order from the governor, face coverings are required to be worn outside (ages 2 and older) when six feet of social distancing between non-household members is not possible. Due to high demand and limited parking space, Evesham Township asks that visitors to the Black Run keep their visits to one hour of time or less, in order to give other visitors a chance to utilize the preserve. Visitors to the preserve must use only the designated parking area. Residents should leave if the designated park area is full. Parking along roads is not allowed.
- **THE EVESHAM COMMUNITY GARDEN** is **OPEN** to those with plots. All state-mandated social distancing guidelines still apply. Whenever possible, individuals/families must keep at least six feet of distance from any other, non-household members who are also visiting the same site. Per executive order from the governor, face coverings are required to be worn outside (ages 2 and older) when six feet of social distancing between non-household members is not possible.
- **THE EVESHAM TOWNSHIP DOG PARK** is **OPEN**. All state-mandated social distancing guidelines still apply. Whenever possible, individuals/families must keep at least six feet of distance from any other, non-household members who are also visiting the same site. Per executive order from the governor, face coverings are required to be worn outside (ages 2 and older) when six feet of social distancing between non-household members is not possible.
- **THE EVESHAM DPW YARD (Recycling Center)** is **OPEN** six days a week, Monday through Saturday, from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. Social distancing guidelines of six feet must be practiced while visiting the yard, and residents must face wear masks or face coverings. Staff will be on-site to provide guidance only. Residents must be prepared and capable of unloading all items they have brought for disposal. Appointments are no longer required.
- **THE INDIAN SPRING GOLF COURSE** is **OPEN** through an **online only** reservation and payment process at www.indianspringgolf.com. Tee Times are 10 minutes apart and open to foursomes, per Executive Order from the Governor's Office. The **DRIVING RANGE** at Indian Spring is also open.
